Custody certificate filed in the Court today is taken on record.

The petitioner had issued a cheque bearing No.716388, dated 22.02.2013 for Rs.5,00,000/-, which was dishonoured by bank with remarks 'Account closed'.

The present revision petition is pressed only on the point of quantum of sentence.

Custody certificate shows that the petitioner is also a previous convict in two other cases. His sentence in the present case is yet to start.

Considering the fact that not even a single rupee out of the cheque amount of ₹5,00,000/- has been paid to the complainant, there is no

ground to reduce the sentence of rigorous imprisonment for one year.

As such, the present revision petition is dismissed.
