Grievance of the petitioner relates to his promotion to the post of Guage Reader since he has been working against post of Guage Reader w.e.f. 14.02.2003. Perusal of posting him as a Guage Reader vide order dated 14.02.2003 even though it is stated that he has been promoted temporary to the post of Guage Reader for a period of 3 months against a vacant post. Still petitioner is not entitled to hold the post of Guage Reader for the reasons that he is in the cadre of Beldar whereas the method of recruitment to the post of Guage Reader is by promoting Mate. Whereas promotional post to the post of Beldar is Mate. Unless and until petitioner enters cadre of Mate he is not entitled to hold the post of Guage Reader. Merely, mentioning that the petitioner has been promoted to the post of Guage Reader for a period of 3 months, petitioner would not get any right having regard to the method of recruitment to the post of Guage

Reader from the post of Mate. Undisputedly, petitioner has not entered the source cadre of Mate to the post of Guage Reader. Moreover, as on the date of filling of this petition he was not working as a Guage Reader as is evident from Annexure R6 an affidavit filed by the petitioner on 15.07.2014 which reveals that petitioner was working as a Beldar. Thus, the petitioner has not approached this court with clean hands by giving factual aspects of the service particulars of the petitioner.

Therefore, CWP stands dismissed.
