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“The petitioners are admittedly working as part time Sweepers/Watermen for the last more than 10 years and are seeking regularization. One of the grounds taken to deny their claim is that there are no regular posts where the petitioners are working since the job requirement of the petitioners is for less than full day; for instance some are working in small

primary schools where the sweeper is required only for two hours. I put it to counsel for the respondents that once it is admitted that there is regular requirement for these posts, even though the work may not be enough to occupy a person for full day, whether the government should not consider encadering part time posts which are otherwise regular in nature, she seeks an adjournment.

Let the Chief Secretary Haryana file his personal affidavit after considering this issue before the next date of hearing. Adjourned to 10.8.2015. Copy of this order be handed over dasti to counsel for the respondents under the signatures of the Bench Secretary.

Photocopy of this order be placed on the connected matter.”

On 15.11.2016 the following order was passed :-

“Ms. Goyal on instructions submits that the petitioners can only be regularized as and when substantive vacancy arises to give benefit of policy of regularization prevailing prior to one floated in 2014. A priority list has been formulated in the department and some persons like the petitioners have already been regularized and the process is going on. The petitioners would have to await their turn for regularization as per seniority.

In view of this on going process, this case is adjourned to 14.3.2017.

A photocopy of this order be placed on the connected file.”

Learned Assistant Advocate General again states that the case of the petitioners would be considered for regularization as per their seniority.

In this view of the matter, both the petitions stand disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil
Miscellaneous Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
