Petitioners have filed this writ petition praying that respondents be directed to take steps to rehabilitate the petitioners, who are residents of the colony and belong to 'Shirkiband Clan'.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioners are being evicted in view of the decree passed by the court below. They are not being harassed in any manner. He, however, submits that in case representation is submitted by the petitioners for their rehabilitation, same shall be considered by the Deputy Commissioner, Fatehgarh Sahib.

Under the circumstances, no case for interference in writ jurisdiction is made out. Petitioners shall be at liberty to make a representation to respondent No.2. Petition is hereby dismissed.
