AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioners have claimed that respondent No.1 was illegally not regularizing their admission.

By way of interim order they were allowed to take the examination and now have finished the course. In the reply filed by respondent No.-1-University has taken the stand that the respondent No.2 had illegally admitted these two students and has stated that they would have no objection in approving the admission of the petitioners (and rather have approved the same) subject to payment of Rs.2 lacs as fine (Rs.1 lac

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per student). Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No. 2 states that this is a completely illegal demand and in fact on the instructions of the respondent No.2 a writ petition is already being prepared to challenge this illegal order.

In the circumstances, petition stands dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
