For the reasons stated in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, application is allowed.

Short affidavit on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2 is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

Main case

Reply on behalf of respondent No.3 has been filed in the Court today. Same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

The petitioners have approached this Court with following relief:-

“Prayer for the issuance of writ of mandamus directing the

official respondents to save the life and property of the petitioners and with a further prayer to grant the police help to the petitioners, so that the petitioners may be able to undertake the agricultural operation, without any fear to life, through the hands of respondent No.4 and others”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that many complaints have been given to the police to protect the life and liberty and allow the petitioners to cultivate the land.

Reply given by the State indicates that none of the representation attached with the writ petition have been received in their office.

As far as cultivation of the land is concerned, petitioners are at liberty to seek injunction against the respondents, but with regard to the other relief in respect of protection of life and liberty of the petitioners, let this writ petition be treated as representation and Sr. Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur-respondent No.3 is directed to decide the same within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

With the aforementioned observations, present writ petition stands disposed of.
