Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the order dated 09.04.2015 (Annexure P-6) of the Financial Commissioner (Revenue), Haryana/respondent No.1, appointing respondent No.6 as Lambardar of Village Jawahara, Tehsil Gohana. District Sonapat, is not justified as at the best, it could have remitted the matter back to the Assistant Collector Grade-I, to decide the controversy with regard to the filling up the post of Lambardar in view of the *munadi* already effected, in essence, three applicants had applied for the same.

Keeping in view the aforementioned facts, the order dated 09.04.2015 (Annexure P-6) of the Financial Commissioner (Revenue), Haryana, is hereby set aside and the matter is remitted back to the Assistant

Collector Grade-I to decide the matter i.e. filling up the post of Lambardar amongst three applicants, already indicated in the order, as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the parties and as well as the parties are directed to appear before the Assistant Collector Grade-I on 20.03.2017.

With the aforesaid observation, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
