The cause of action has not arisen within the jurisdiction of this Court. The resignation letter was submitted by the petitioner while he was serving in Saharanpur Main Branch of the Central Bank of India in Uttar Pradesh. The resignation letter dated November 09, 2015 was addressed to the Regional Manager, Central Bank of India, Meerut. The resignation was to take effect from the expiry of three months from the date of notice of resignation. The letter of resignation was approved by the Senior Manager HRD, Meerut vide letter dated February 05, 2016. The petitioner withdrew the resignation on March 11, 2016 while in Saharanpur. He was informed that his resignation had been duly accepted by the competent authority by a letter of the Assistant General Manager HRD to the petitioner at his address in Lucknow.

Neither has the cause of action nor any part thereof arisen within the territory of this Court nor do the respondents reside or do business within the limits of this Court concerning the petitioner and,

therefore, the petition is not maintainable. Is is accordingly dismissed for want of territorial jurisdiction. The petitioner may approach the proper forum for redressal of his grievance, if any and as advised.
