At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a similar matter has already been disposed of by this Court in CWP No. 25213 of 2013, captioned as “*Bhag Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another*”, decided on 18.11.2013 (Annexure P-6) and the instant petition be also disposed of in terms thereof.

2. Learned State counsel submits that he has no objection, if, the instant petition is disposed of in terms of the order dated 18.11.2013 passed in above referred writ petition i.e. *Bhag Singh's* case (supra) (Annexure P-6).

3. Accordingly, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Director Public Instructions (Schools), Punjab, Punjab School Education Building, Phase VIII, Mohali to look into the grievances unfolded by

the petitioner in his representation dated 01.02.2014 (Annexure P-5) and decide the same, particularly, in view of ***Bhag Singh's*** case (supra) (Annexure P-6), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. Since, the main petition is disposed of, IOIN-CWP-12902-2014 is also disposed of.
