Respondent No.1 is today again present in Court and has produced an identity card issued by the Election Commission of India.

On a specific query put to him, he has submitted that he has compromised the matter with the petitioner and has no objection to the entire proceedings against the petitioner, which arise out of the dishonouring of a cheque, being quashed.

Keeping in view the fact that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties, it would be in the interest of peace to quash the criminal proceedings.

Consequently, the petition is allowed and Complaint No.COMA/30172/2013, instituted under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, along with all proceedings arising therefrom, is hereby quashed, and the petitioner is acquitted of the charge framed against him.
