The instant revision petition is directed against the concurrent conviction of the petitioner under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act.

Counsel, at the very outset, submits that he would have no cogent ground to assail the conviction.

This Court has also perused the judgement passed by the Trial Court as also the judgement passed by the 1st Appellate Court, whereby the conviction has been affirmed. Conviction of the petitioner has been recorded for cogent and valid reasoning and upon due appreciation of the evidence adduced on record.

As per prayer made by the counsel present petition is dismissed as not pressed.

At this stage, counsel contends that sentence of the petitioner be suspended on the ground that marriage of the daughter of the petitioner is slated for 28.3.2017.

While dismissing the instant petition, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file an appropriate application seeking interim bail on the ground of marriage of his daughter.

Petition is dismissed.
