REKHA MITTAL, J.

The present petition directs challenge against consistent findings recorded by the Courts below whereby the respondents have been acquitted of the offence punishable under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (in short 'IPC') by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar vide judgment dated 06.05.2016 and the appeal preferred by the State through Sharanjit Kaur – complainant did not find favour with the Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar and as a result findings recorded by the trial Court were affirmed.

I have gone through the judgments passed by the Courts below but do not find any error much less patent illegality in the findings constituting a substantial and compelling reason for this Court to differ with the findings recorded by the Courts below. In this view of the matter, the petition fails and is accordingly dismissed.
