By this petition, the order of the learned trial Court, dismissing an application filed under Section 311 Cr.P.C., has been challenged.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner simply wishes to lead evidence before the learned trial Court that respondents no. 2 and 3, i.e. the accused in the FIR, were also accused in another FIR of like nature and that they had been playing a fraud on a number of people.

A perusal of the impugned order shows that 19 opportunities had been given to the prosecution to conclude its evidence and it is only when the matter was fixed for arguments, that the application in question was filed.

Considering the fact that the evidence sought to be led is not otherwise directly concerned with the FIR in question and several opportunities had been granted to the prosecution to lead its evidence, I find

no reason to interfere with the order of the learned trial Court.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed.
