S.S. SARON,J.

The writ petition has been filed by Raahat Safe Community Foundation under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, requiring that compensation be paid to the private vehicle owners as according to the petitioner there has been wrongful implementation of the High Security Registration Plate Scheme (HSRP) and in respect of the same, correction is liable to be made; besides, exemplary cost against the concessionarie, are liable to be imposed. A further prayer has been made for cancellation of the Type Approval Certificate (TAC) and also for Black Listing the concessionaire and its promoter company for having violated the public policy and compromising the public interest ensuing therein.

No one has been appearing for the petitioner for the last several dates, when the case was taken up. Even otherwise, any person, who is

aggrieved against the wrongful implementation of the High Security

Registration Plate Scheme (HSRP) which has resulted in wrongful loss to him, has a remedy in accordance with law. The petitioner has not shown as to whether it has been authorised by the private vehicle owners to claim compensation on their behalf.

In the circumstances, without going into the aspect as have been raised, the writ petition is liable to be dismissed in default, for non-appearance of anyone on behalf of the petitioner.

Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed in default. In case anyone has a claim for compensation, he may seek his remedy in accordance with law.
