The present petition has been filed on behalf of the juvenile, who seeks regular bail in FIR No.0190 dated 23.06.2016, registered under Sections 307, 323, 452 and 506 IPC, at Police Station Chand Hut, District Palwal.

Seeking regular bail for the petitioner, learned counsel submits that the petitioner, who is in juvenile, is in custody for the last over nine months; there is no other criminal cases pending against the petitioner; the trial is yet to begin and, therefore, is not likely to conclude in the near future.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the above factual position.

In view of the above, in my opinion, the petitioner be admitted to regular bail.
