RITU BAHRI, J.

This order shall dispose of CRR-649 and 651 of 2017 arising out of the same FIR No. 63 dated 25.2.2016 under Sections 498-A, 304-B read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Chandut, District Palwal.

Present revision has been filed against the summoning order dated 30.11.2016 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Palwal in an application filed under Section 319, Cr. P.C. whereby the petitioner(s) has been summoned to face trial in the FIR in question.

The case was set up on the statement of Mahender Singh son of Hukam Singh, in which it is stated that he solemnized the marriage of his deceased daughter with Devender Singh on 21.4.2015. After some time, Devender Singh and his relatives started harassing the daughter of complainant on account of bringing less dowry. Due to temperamental differences, both the parties could not live together and ultimately deceased

dated on 24.2.2016.

Learned counsel for State submits that report has been received from the trial Court that bail bonds are accepted.

In view of above, no ground is made out to quash the summoning order dated 30.11.2016.

Both petitions are dismissed.

However, personal appearance of petitioner(s) before the trial Court is exempted subject to the following conditions:-

(i) petitioner shall be represented through counsel; (ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings; (iii) shall not dispute his identity as an accused; (iv) shall have no objection if, the prosecution evidence is recorded in his absence, but in the presence of his counsel; (v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required; and (vi) any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.
