1. The petitioners have approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing respondents No. 1 to 3 to record the petitioners as owner of the land as mentioned in head note of the petition which was purchased by them after paying ₹ 1.77 crores to respondent No. 4-Bank in pursuance to the settlement dated 21.10.2014 (Annexure P-13) entered into between respondents No. 4 and 5.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the instant petition, with

Tribunal, by raising all the pleas as have been sought to be raised herein under the provisions of Recovery of Debts Due to Banks and Financial Institutions Act, 1993.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies, as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
