The petitioners have approached this Court seeking to challenge acquisition of land. Notifications under Sections 4 and 6 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, were issued on 9.12.2013 and 5.12.2014, respectively. The purpose for which the land was sought to be acquired is for the development and utilization of land for Sector Part Road, and Sector-9B, Open Space Zone at Gurgaon (now Gurugram).

Learned counsel for the State submitted that after reconsidering the entire matter, the Government has decided to drop the acquisition proposed to be carried out vide aforesaid notifications.

In view of the aforesaid stand taken by learned counsel for the State, the prayer made in the writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
