For the reasons stated in the application, delay of 50 days in filing the revision is condoned.

Application stands disposed of.

**CRR No.817 of 2017**

The petitioner has come up in revision against the order dated 13.09.2016 passed by learned ASJ, Patiala whereby application under Section 5 of Limitation Act for condoning of delay of 347 days in filing the appeal was dismissed and impugned judgment dated 19.11.2014 passed by learned JMIC, Patiala whereby respondent No.2 was acquitted.

A perusal of the order dated 13.09.2016 shows that after passing of the order of judgment of acquittal dated 19.11.2014, the petitioner filed the application alongwith the appeal after a period of more than one year on the ground that she remained ill and bed ridden for a long period but no supporting document in this regard has been produced. Learned Court below had justified that petitioner had failed to prove any reason as to why she has

file the appeal for a long period of more than one year. Learned Court below had rightly dismissed the application for want of medical record and sufficient ground.

So in the light of the discussion, the orders of the Courts below do not reflect any material irregularity or perversity which warrant interference. Hence the present revision stands dismissed.
