Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he had informed the petitioner regarding order passed by this Court on the last date of hearing directing him to surrender before the trial Court immediately, but he has no intimation as to whether he has in fact surrendered or not. This is gross violation of order passed by this Court.

A perusal of the interim orders goes to show that learned counsel for the petitioner had been seeking time to bring demand draft amounting to ₹40,000/- to be paid to the complainant in terms of order

dated 08.05.2017, but it was not so done. Again, the direction of the Court in that regard has been flouted.

This revision petition has been filed with a delay of 312 days, no satisfactory explanation for the same has been rendered, under the circumstances, the revision petition cannot proceed further and is dismissed accordingly.

The Courts below be informed in that regard so that necessary process could be initiated to effect arrest of the petitioner and to put him behind bars to undergo the sentence.
