The petitioners herein are working with Guru Nank Dev University, which is 95% aided Institute, and seek for deduction of CPF @ 10% of their salary, in accordance with the minutes of the meeting held on 23rd June, 2010, which was approved on 18th June, 2010. In this regard, a legal notice was served by by the petitioners upon the respondents and the Principal of the said College, in turn, addressed a letter to the DPI (Colleges) asking them to take a decision of their own. However, no action was taken thereafter, aggrieved the instant writ petition has been preferred.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is limiting his prayer that the decision be taken regarding deduction of 10% of the salary towards CPF in accordance with the minutes of the meeting that was held on 23rd June,

2010 and approved on 18th June, 2010.

In view of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No. 1 and 2 to consider instant writ petition as representation and decide the same by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case, the petitioners are found entitled to the relief so claimed, the needful will be done within three months thereafter.
