For the reasons mentioned in the application the same is allowed and delay of 92 days in filing the present revision petition stands condoned.

**CRR-926 -2017 (O&M)**

The present revision petition is directed against the judgment 3.9.2016, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad affirming the judgment of conviction dated 6.9.2014 and order of sentence dated 12.9.2014 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Faridabad vide which, the present revision petitioner was convicted for commission of an offence punishable under Section 138 Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and sentenced to undergo Rigorous Imprisonment for one year along with

compensation of Rs.12,25,000/-, which was to be paid within one month, failing which, the present petitioner was to further undergo Simple Imprisonment for three months.

Petitioner had issued a cheque for Rs.10,18,000/- which was dishonoured by the bank on account of “insufficient funds”. Both the Courts have recorded the concurrent findings that the accused had admitted the liability of issuance of cheque. Accused petitioner had not paid even a single penny to the complainant nor any assurance is given that the same will be paid.

It being so, there is no ground to interfere in the concurrent findings of both the Courts below.

Resultantly, the present revision petition is dismissed.
