Rekha Mittal, J.

The present petition directs challenge against order dated 13.12.2016 passed by the District Judge (Family Court), Rahtak whereby the petitioner had been directed to pay maintenance at the rate of Rs. 10,000/- per month to the wife and at the same rate to each of the two children born out of the wedlock.

On 5.4.2017, order passed by this Court reads as follows:-

“Counsel for the petitioner would submit that the respondent-wife is in possession of the entire second floor of the building but she has not rented out any of the flats on the second floor.

On a query by the court, counsel has informed that the petitioner has not paid any maintenance to the respondent in pursuance of the impugned order.

The petitioner is directed to clear arrears of maintenance at the rate of Rs. 10,000/- per month each awarded to two children of the parties within one month.

Adjourned to 11.5.2017.

The petitioner shall place on record his affidavit alongwith documents with regard to clearing arrears of maintenance.”

Counsel for the petitioner would state that the petitioner is not ready to clear arrears of maintenance at the rate of Rs. 10,000/- per month to each of the two children born out of the wedlock for the reason that the respondent-wife is not permitting him to meet the children.

As the petitioner has failed to comply with the directions issued by this Court, he has disentitled himself to be heard on merits of the petition.
