This petition has been filed against the order dated 17.02.2017 passed by the District Judge, Family Court, Pathankot, directing employer of the petitioner (husband) to deduct his 1/3rd salary every month and send the said amount to the Court in the form of demand draft to be paid to Madhu Bala-respondent No.1 (wife) as maintenance.

A perusal of the file shows that petitioner-husband has not cleared the arrears of maintenance and approximately a sum of Rs.1,83,000/- is recoverable from him.

Since the petitioner has not paid maintenance to the respondent-wife and the minor daughter, therefore the trial Court has rightly passed the impugned order directing the employer of the petitioner to deduct his salary to the extent of 1/3 share and send the said amount to the Court, so that the arrears of maintenance could be cleared.

In these circumstances, the impugned order does not suffer from

any illegality, much less perversity, warranting interference by this Court.

Dismissed.
