LISA GILL, J.

The petitioner has impugned order dated 03.01.2017 passed by the learned District Judge, Family Court, Gurugram whereby maintenance to the tune of ₹4,000/- per month to respondent No. 1 and ₹3,000/- per month each to respondents No. 2 and 3 has been assessed. The petitioner was directed to clear arrears of maintenance at the rate of ₹8,000/- per month within a period of two months on 05.04.2017. There was non-compliance of the said order and the petitioner was directed to be present in Court vide order dated 04.07.2017.

Following order was passed on 21.09.2017 when neither the arrears of maintenance were cleared nor the petitioner came present in Court:-

“ The petitioner was directed to clear the arrears of maintenance at the rate of ₹ 8000/- per month within a period of two months on 05.04.2017. He was directed to be present in person in Court today. Neither, the said amount has been deposited despite opportunity nor the petitioner is present in Court today. It is submitted that the petitioner is unable to be present due to some unavoidable circumstances, though the circumstances are not spelled out.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 01.11.2017.

In case, order dated 05.04.2017 is not complied with by the next date of hearing and the petitioner is not present in person, this petition shall automatically stand dismissed on the said date.”

It is informed that order dated 05.04.2017 passed by this Court has not been complied with, neither is the petitioner present in Court today.

In view of the above, the present revision petition stands dismissed.
