Prayer in this petition is for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus of *habeas corpus* for producing the detenue i.e. Prabhjot Kaur-daughter of the petitioner. It is the allegation that she is in illegal detention of respondents No.4 to 9.

In pursuance to the notice of motion, Mr. S.S. Goraya, Advocate has appeared for the detenue-Prabhjot Kaur and Mr. Sumeet Singh Arora, Advocate has appeared for respondents No.4 to 9. The detenue is present in the Court with lady constable Aman Kumari and has filed an affidavit through her counsel that she has left her parental home on 20.07.2017 and her husband-Navdeep Singh and her in-laws were harassing and humiliating her for bringing less dowry. She has further deposed in the affidavit that she has gone to the house of Saravjit Kaur-respondent No.6 and she is residing there voluntarily without any pressure.

It is further submitted in the affidavit that she do not wish to join the company of her husband or her parents as she feel a threat to her life and liberty.

In view of the affidavit filed by the detenue-Prabhjot Kaur, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this petition may be rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
