Prayer in this petition is for issuance of writ of habeas corpus for releasing the detainee, namely, Amrit Pal Singh s/o Wassan Singh, from the custody of respondents No.3 to 5.

Vide order dated 05.09.2017, Warrant Officer was appointed who has submitted a report dated 07.09.2017.

Reply, by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, STF Border Range, Amritsar, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5 and reply by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police-Investigation, Amritsar, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 have been filed separately in Court today, which are taken on record.

As per reply filed by Assistant Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, the detainee Amrit Pal Singh was not wanted in any case by the police of C.I.A. Staff, Amritsar.

As per reply filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police, the detainee was arrested in FIR No.19, dated 03.09.2017, under Sections 21, 25, 29, 61, 85 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station, Special State Operation Cell, Amritsar City and has been remanded in police custody by

Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Amritsar and further proceedings in the FIR
are going on.

In view of the above, no further action is required.

Accordingly, the present petition has rendered infructuous.
