Petitioner has prayed for the following relief:-

“I. issue writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to frame a policy for regularization of casual/temporary employees working with them for more than 10 years as on 10.04.2006 in pursuance of the direction issued by Hon'ble Supreme Court in case of Secretary, State of Karnataka Vs. Uma Devi decided on 10.04.2006 (reported as AIR 2006 SC 1806);

II. Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the petitioner for regularization who is working with the respondents for more than 21 years as on date.”

Pursuant to the directions issued on 27.09.2017, the respondent-Central Bank of India had passed speaking order on 24.11.2017 considering the grievance of the petitioner.

In view of the speaking order dated 24.11.2017, present petition do not survive for consideration. Hence, petition stands disposed of reserving liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order dated 24.11.2017.
