Prayer made in the petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for extension of parole, being currently availed by the petitioner, on the ground that there is imminent need for him to undergo surgery for the purpose of ACL reconstruction.

The petitioner is presently undergoing sentence of imprisonment in case FIR No. 188 dated 14.6.2002 under Sections 399, 402 and 307 IPC, registered at Police Station Nissing. According to him, he had suffered injuries on both his knees, for which, he had been consulting the orthopaedician in the Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and

Research, Chandigarh after being referred by the Medical Officer, District Jail Kurukshetra. He was recommended surgery for ACL reconstruction. It is also submitted that he stands released on parole on 22.8.2017 for a period of twenty two days and is now required to surrender before the jail authorities on 14.9.2017. He wants to undergo the requisite surgery and has recently consulted Dr. Karan Sobti of Dr. Sobti's Orthocare, Meharban Complex, Jagadhri Road, Ambala Cantt. on 5.9.2017, who after examining him has advised ACL reconstruction of right knee followed by left knee. Further, he had been asked to get admission in the hospital on 11.9.2017 so that the surgery was performed on 12.9.02017. It is submitted that the present petition was filed on 6.9.2017 but the Office raised certain objections. The objections were duly removed and the petition refiled on 7.9.2017. The counsel for the petitioner, thereafter, made request for early hearing and, accordingly, the same has been passed for hearing before this Court. Under these circumstances, he could not get himself admitted in Dr. Sobti's hospital but has been assured that he can get himself admitted in the next two days.

Notice of motion. Mr. Pramjeet Singh, Assistant Advocate General Haryana accepts notice. Copy of the petition alongwith its annexures has been supplied by the learned counsel

for the petitioner to the learned State counsel in the Court itself.

Heard. Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is required to undergo ACL reconstruction of both of his knees, a case is made out for extension of his parole for one week. Resultantly, the petition is disposed of by extending parole upto 21.9.2017.
