The instant criminal writ petition (habeas corpus) has been registered after receipt of an e-mail from Aastha Dewan, wherein it is alleged that her mother, namely, Neerja Batra was called to women police station at Sector-51, Gurgaon, for recording her statement at 08:00 PM on Sunday evening i.e. 10.09.2017. After recording her statement by Ms. Kailash, SHO she was told to wait for ACP. The ACP did not turn up till late night and suddenly her mother was taken in a car by 4/5 police officers/police women at around 1:00 AM on 11.09.2017, but they did not inform her as to where they are taking her mother.

Learned State counsel has filed the affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Pataudi, District Gurugram, wherein, it is stated that the alleged detainee was called to the police station. As she was feeling uneasy, she was taken to the hospital and her statement was recorded in the hospital itself. After recording her statement, she was allowed to go home along with her husband.

In view of the reply filed by learned State counsel in the form of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Pataudi, District Gurugram, no further directions are called for in this petition, which stands disposed of.
