Prayer in this petition is for grant of four weeks' parole to the petitioner on account of marriage of his son.

Reply by way of affidavit of Rattan Singh, Superintendent, District Jail, Gurugram, on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record, in which it is stated as under:-

“that the petitioner was released on 02.12.2002 for four weeks parole and was directed to surrender at Jail Gate on 31.12.2002 but the petitioner did not surrender on due date i.e. on 31.12.2002 and absconded from parole and was re-arrested by Local Police on 02.04.2014 after overstay of 11 years, 03 months and 01 days and for which a case FIR No.271 dated 01.05.2003, under Section 8/9 HGCP Act, PS City Gurugram was registered against the convict which by undergone by the learned Court of Sh. Amit Nain, JMIC Gurugram on 04.11.2016.”

In view of the above, learned State counsel submits that there is an apprehension that if the petitioner is granted parole again, he will misuse the concession of parole.

Dismissed.
