Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for the release of detenue namely Paramjit Singh, cousin of the petitioner, who has been illegally confined by respondent No. 3.

Vide order dated 22.9.2017, Warrant Officer was appointed who has submitted a report on 23.9.2017, in which he has stated that while he was going to the Police Station Patara, on his way petitioner informed him that the detenue-Paramjit Singh has been released by the Police Station Patara. Therefore, the present petitioner-Gurpal Singh is not interested in conducting the raid at Police Station Patara. Accordingly, Warrant Officer came back to Chandigarh. He has also attached the statement of the petitioner which is annexed as Annexure R-1 with the report dated 23.9.2017.

In view of above, no further action is required to be taken in the present petition.
