The present petition has been filed seeking parole for four weeks on account of marriage of daughter of the petitioner.

Notice of motion was issued and learned State counsel has filed an affidavit of Manjeet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda. As per the reply, request for parole made by the petitioner, was rejected vide order dated 22.09.2017, probably on the ground that conduct of the petitioner was not satisfactory for atleast four months after his conviction.

The case of the petitioner is that his daughter is getting married and he is seeking parole for the said purpose. This fact has not been denied in the affidavit filed on behalf of the State. Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has only one daughter, I deem it just and appropriate to grant parole to the petitioner for one week from today. He shall surrender in Jail on 13.10.2017 positively.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
