Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing the respondents No.1 to 4 to release the alleged detainee, namely, Buta Singh, who is brother of the petitioner and is in illegal detention of respondents No.3 and 4.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rishi Pal, states that the alleged detainee is not in the illegal detention of police, rather, he was admitted in Civil Hospital, Sector-6, Panchkula on account of some fire arm injury suffered by him during the riots occurred in Panchkula after the verdict of the case of Dera Sacha Sauda, Sirsa.

In view of the categorical statement made by learned State counsel, this Court finds that there is no merit in the present petition and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.
