Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing the respondents No.1 to 4 to release the alleged detainee, namely, Kuldeep, who is brother of the petitioner and is in illegal detention of respondents No.3 and 4.

Dr. Naresh Kaler, Medical Officer, Civil Hospital, Panchkula is present in the Court and states that the alleged detainee is not in the illegal detention of police, rather, he was admitted in the hospital on account of some fire arm injury. Now he is fit to be discharged, but he is not inclined to seek his discharge from the hospital.

In view of the categorical statement made by Dr. Naresh Kaler, this Court finds that there is no merit in the present petition and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.
