Counsel for the parties are ad-idem that in view of the order dated 4.9.2017 the benefits have been granted and the present petition has been rendered infructuous. The order passed by respondent no.3 reads as under:-

“In pursuance of the decision taken in the meeting of the Governing Body of Welfare Society for the Home for Persons with Special Needs, Rohtak held on 20.4.2011, the staff of State Institute for Rehabilitation, Training & Research (SIRTAR) is hereby granted pay scales as per 6th Pay Commission in accordance with the notification issued vide Haryana Government No.GSR 44/Const./Art.309/08 dated 30.12.2008 subject to the following terms & conditions:-

1. These shall deemed to have come into force on 1st day of January, 2009.
2. The arrears on account of salary from the period from 01.01.2009 would be payable in 3 consecutive yearly installments of 40:30:30 ratio of the total arrears till

31.07.2017.

3. Ist installment of 40% arrear would be payable during the year 2017-18.
4. 2nd and 3rd installment of 30% each of arrears would be payable during the year 2018-19 and 2019-20 respectively.”

Accordingly, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such. However, it is expected that respondents shall adhere to the terms of the order dated 4.9.2017.
