KULDIP SINGH, J (ORAL)

An application dated 21.09.17 of Major Singh S/o Arjun Singh resident of Village Ratta Tiba, Tehsil Malout, District Muktsar, has been received by post which has been treated as a Criminal Writ Petition (Habeas Corpus). The allegations in the said complaint are that the accused has enticed the daughter of complainant for the purpose of marriage and took her away. The prayer is that an FIR in this case is required to be registered.

It comes out that it appears to be the case of run away marriage. The prayer in the said application is for registration of an FIR, therefore, it is not the case of illegal detention.

In view of the matter, the present petition stands dismissed.

The petitioner is always at liberty to approach the concerned Illaqa Magistrate with appropriate prayer, if he so desired.
