Prayer made in the petition filed by convict-Sagar Chauhan is for extension of parole, which was granted upto October 10, 2017.

The petition had come up for preliminary hearing before this Court on 6.10.2017, when after hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, notice of motion was issued for 12.10.2017. On 12.10.2017, learned State counsel prayed for a short adjournment for filing the reply. The reply was filed on the adjourned date, i.e. 24.10.2017. However, as none had put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner, the hearing was adjourned

for today.

As per the reply filed by the Jail Superintendent on behalf of the respondents, the petitioner had earlier absconded from parole for one month and twenty eight days and, accordingly, FIR No. 401 dated 23.11.2011 under Sections 8 and 9 of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners' (Temporary Release) Act, Police Station Baldev Nagar was registered against him. It has also been mentioned that on 7.10.2017, when the petitioner surrendered at the jail gate, he was found in possession of mobile phone concealed in his socks and cash amount of Rs. 5,000/- concealed in his underwear. As he violated the parole rules/discipline of the jail, FIR No. 1489 dated 9.10.2017 under Section 42-A of Prisons Act was also registered against him at Police Station Jagadhri.

In view of the above, the petitioner has disintitled himself for seeking his release on parole.

The petition is without any merit and, therefore, dismissed.
