This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India issuing direction to respondents for grant of six weeks parole to the petitioner to meet his family members and to settle the household affairs under Section 3 (1)(d) of Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962.

Learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer only that the respondents may be directed to decide the application of the petitioner for releasing him on six weeks parole expeditiously.
