ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking extension of his parole for a period of 8 weeks.

The petitioner was convicted by the trial Court in FIR No. 34 dated 13.03.2011, under Sections 15/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Chhajli, District Sangrur and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of 10 years.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has already undergone an actual sentence of about 07 years and he was released on parole on 05.09.2017 for a period of 42 days as he suffered serious spinal injury, when he had fallen down from the mango tree. He had been asked by the jail authorities to climb the mango tree for cutting its branches although the petitioner is stated to have refused but under pressure of the authorities, he climbed the tree and fell down as he was not used to

this work. He was taken to Civil Hospital, Sangrur and Rajindra Hospital, Patiala and thereafter referred to PGI, Chandigarh. The copies of the medical record of the petitioner are annexed as Annexure P-1 collectively.

Learned counsel also contends that the petitioner is also HIV positive and as the condition of the petitioner has not improved as he is still confined to bed.

Reply has been filed in the form of affidavit which indicates that the petitioner is not fit to walk and is suffering the effects of the injury sustained by him in jail.

At this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities by 05.12.2017 as the petitioner intends to file an application for suspension of his sentence on medical grounds.

Consequently, the parole of the petitioner is extended till 05.12.2017. The petitioner shall surrender before the Superintendent, District Jail, Sangrur by 05:00 p.m. on 05.12.2017.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
