Petitioner has filed the present petition for a direction to the respondents to grant parole to him for a period of two months under the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 for agricultural purpose claiming that his father died on 12.09.2017 and he was granted concession of interim suspension of his sentence for period of six days. After having surrendered, he submitted an application through his wife Paramjit Kaur to the Superintendent District Jail, Karnal copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-2 dated 30.09.2017 but the same has not been decided so far.

Through the present petition, a direction has been sought for grant of parole for a period of two months for agricultural purpose as there is no male member left in the family to harvest and sowing the seasonal crops.

Since the application for agricultural parole has been submitted only on 30.09.2017, we deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition in limine.

Notice of the petition to Advocate General, Haryana.

On asking of the Court, Mr. S.S. Pannu, DAG, Haryana, present in the Court, accepts notice.

Counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over three sets of paper book to the State counsel, during course of the day.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the State authorities to consider the application filed by Paramjit Kaur, wife of the petitioner, Annexure P-2, for grant of parole for harvesting and sowing the crops, within a period of 15 days after the receipt of certified copy of the order. It is further directed that in case for any reason, it is found that application Annexure P-2 dated 30.09.2017 has not been actually received for processing by the Superintendent Jail, the present petition may be treated as an application for parole to be considered within a period of 15 days.
