ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for the release of his sister namely Ritu Kalra and her minor daughter namely Siya Kalra, who are stated to be illegally detained by respondent No.3, at the instance of respondents No.4 to 6 since 12.10.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the alleged detainees were picked up by respondent No.3 on 12.10.2017 in the evening and had been illegally detained.

This Court, by the order dated 13.10.2017, had appointed a Warrant Officer, who was to accompany the petitioner and locate the alleged detainees. The Warrant Officer

has filed his report dated 16.10.2017, wherein it is stated that the alleged detenues were illegally detained in a room in the house of respondent No.4, who is husband of alleged detainee Ritu Kalra and father of alleged detainee Siya Kalra and they were released by the Warrant Officer.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties.

As per the report of Warrant Officer, both the alleged detenues have been released. Consequently, no further directions or orders are required to be passed in the instant petition and the same stands disposed of.
