This order shall dispose of 11 writ petitions bearing CWP Nos. 12422, 13658, 13742, 14252, 14253, 14696, 21679, 26045, 22583, 25995 and 22498 of 2016. However, the facts are being extracted from CWP No. 12422 of 2016.

This petition is directed against the letter dated 22.04.2016 sent by the District Revenue Officer, Karnal-cum-Chairman Administration/Legal Committee, Mandir Sita Mai to the Naib Tehsildar/BDPO and Incharge, Police Post Sita Mai and the letter dated 16.05.2016 written by Naib Tehsildar to the Patwari Halqa, Sita Mai (Namberdaran Deh). A perusal of both the impugned letters indicate that there was no cause of action for the petitioner/s to have filed these writ petitions as no adverse action has been initiated against them. Thus, at this stage, these petitions are premature and, therefore, the same are dismissed as such.
