In view of the latest report regarding the status of the petitioner, submitted by Superintendent of Prisons, Karnal, to the effect that the petitioner is being provided with regular treatment during his confinement in District Prison, Karnal and the required medical treatment or surgery, if advised by concerned Medical Officer, would be arranged by the State under police escort whenever needed, we do not deem it appropriate to pass any direction for grant of parole for the reasons mentioned in the application, especially when the petitioner has already availed parole till 25.10.2017 and there is no imminent threat to his health as per the report. It appears that the petitioner is to be taken to the hospital now on 21.11.2017.

Expecting that the undertaking furnished before this Court would be complied with, the present petition is dismissed at this stage.

In case of any inconvenience or deficient medical treatment,

it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again, for any relief permissible under law.
