Mr.G.S. Nahel, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.5, 6 and 9 and filed vakalatnama on their behalf, which is taken on record.

The alleged detainee Ms.Gurvinder Kaur has appeared in the Court. She is being accompanied by Lady Constable Ms.Meenu Kaur and ASI Teja Singh from Police Station Bareta.

Ms.Gurvinder Kaur has been asked whether she is residing with her parents of her own or she is being illegally detained. She states that she is residing with her parents out of her free will and is not being

illegally detained by her parents i.e. father Mohinder Singh (respondent No.5), mother Paramjit Kaur (respondent No.6) and brother Gurpreet Singh (respondent No.7) besides other private respondents. On being asked whether she had got married with petitioner – Amandeep Singh, she denied the same stating that petitioner – Amandeep Singh is just a friend. Ms.Gurvinder Kaur is aged 25 years, as such, she is a major.

Since Ms.Gurvinder Kaur has appeared in the Court and made a statement aforementioned, no further action in the matter is called for and the present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
