Reply has been filed on behalf of State of Punjab.

Petitioner-Prabhjot Singh, after having been convicted to undergo life imprisonment, is undergoing sentence in Central Jail, Amritsar, after having been transferred from Model Jail, Burail, Chandigarh, w.e.f. 14.09.2017. Petitioner-Prabhjot Singh seeks concession of interim release in order to enable him to attend his ailing mother, who is presently admitted in emergency ward in Navpreet Hospital at Amritsar.

As per the reply filed, the convict-petitioner has already availed 42 days of parole in the present half yearly time period and is not entitled for parole in the same calendar year.

We are satisfied from the medical certificates produced on

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record that the mother of petitioner is at present admitted in a hospital in serious condition. Taking into consideration the conduct of the petitioner of having exercised his right of parole, without creating any breach of peace in the society, and without threatening the security of the State, it is ordered that petitioner-Prabhjot Singh would be released temporarily for a period of seven days on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of District Magistrate, Amritsar, with an undertaking that he will not indulge in any criminal activity or any other act endangering peace and security in the society at Amritsar or at any other place. Petitioner would be released on receipt of release order on 3rd November, 2017 in order to enable him to be present with his mother and to help her in her treatment and will be required to surrender in the Jail at 4.00 PM on 09.11.2017.

In case of violation of any of the conditions, it will be open to the prosecution/respondents to seek cancellation of the present order.

The writ petition is disposed of with aforesaid directions.
