State has filed the inquiry report by way of an affidavit of Balwant Singh, Sub Inspector SHO PS City Barnala on behalf of respondent nos.1 to 3. Himali Goyal (detenue) has been produced before this Court by SI Raj Pal Kaur.

In the reply by State, it has been stated that the statement of Himali Goyal has been recorded by the police as well before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class(Duty), Barnala, wherein she has admitted the marriage but she stated that she is staying with her parents of her own free will. Himali Goyal was also examined by this Court on oath. In her statement before this Court, she has affirmed that she has married to the petitioner Manpreet Singh Deol on 25.10.2017 at Prachin Shiv Mandir Panchkula. She has further stated that thereafter, they had stayed in a hotel

Satyam Village Burail at Sector 45, Chandigarh, from where the petitioner had gone to bring a car but did not return. Thereafter, phone of her parents came and they came to the said hotel and she accompanied with her parents of her free will. She has further stated that she is living with her parents of her free will and does not want to accompany the petitioner. On the request of the petitioner, who is present in Court, he was allowed to talk to Himali Goyal for few minutes. Even after the said talk, Himali Goyal reiterated that she does not want to accompany the petitioner.

It being so, Himali Goyal is allowed to accompany her parents.

The present Habeas Corpus Petition accordingly becomes infructuous and dismissed.
