FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 5th February, 2017 of Police Station Harike, Tehsil Patti, District Tarn Taran, has been received whereby it has been elicited by the police that the marriage of Jagdip Singh son of Rajwant Kaur and Gurbhej Singh resident of village Chawinda Devi, District Amritsar is to be solemnized on 7th/8th February, 2017 with Kuljit Kaur daughter of Kulwinder Kaur and Harjit Singh resident of village Ghuman Kalan at their residence i.e. Ghuman Kalan, District Gurdaspur, which is duly supported by the statements of the respectable and relations as well as by the police along with supporting documents by way of marriage invitation card.

Keeping in view that petitioner-Boota Singh as per this report is real brother-in-law (Jija) being husband of sister of the Jagdip Singh and therefore, as per the prevalent customs and rituals his presence at the time of

marriage is essential.

In view of these circumstances, it would be sub-serve the ends of justice if the petitioner is granted parole for a period of 3 days with effect from today i.e. 06.02.2017 to 08.02.2017 subject to furnishing of personal bonds in the sum of ₹ 2.00 lacs with two sureties in the like amount to the satisfaction of Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar and the petitioner shall surrender before the Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar on 9th February, 2017 at 10.00 a.m.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
