Report of Warrant Officer received.

Alleged detenue-Tanvir Kaur Chohan has appeared in the Court today. She states that she is aged about 24 years and had married with Gursewak Singh of her own on 04.07.2016, as such, she wants to go with her husband-Gursewak Singh. Father of the girl, Sh. Gajinder Singh has stated that he was not aware of the marriage between the petitioner and Tanvir Kaur Chohan and only now he has got information about the marriage. He states that the antecedents of the petitioner are not good and the Gurudwara where the *Anand Karaj* was performed is not a proper Gurudwara. But those aspects are not to be looked into during these proceedings. He may avail of the remedy as per law, if so advised.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that since Tanvir Kaur Chohan has been got recovered and is residing with the petitioner, as such, petitioner does not want to proceed with the petition and he be permitted to withdraw the same.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
