The present petition has been filed under Article 226 read with Article 20 of Constitution of India praying for release of Jyoti Kumar son of Darshan Lal, on emergency parole as the petitioner, his wife, is undertaking treatment for Cancer. She has appended the medical record which has been found to be correct on verification by the State.

Having regard to the aforesaid when the petitioner is said to be undertaking treatment for a serious ailment, we would deem it appropriate to accept the petition and grant Jyoti Kumar son of Darshan Lal, the husband of the petitioner parole for four weeks' commencing from 21.12.2017 to 21.01.2018 in order to enable him to take care of his wife on completion of necessary procedures. Jyoti Kumar son of Darshan Lal is directed to surrender before the jail authorities on 22.01.2018.

Accordingly, Criminal writ petition stands allowed.
